Sub: Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the year 2014-15

As you are aware, BSNL is signing MOU with DOT every year. The purpose of MOU is to agree on performance on various parameters so that the officers of BSNL can work on self motivated basis to achieve the parameters.

- 2. The MOU for the year 2014-15 has been signed by BSNL with DOT on 27.03.2014. The details of the targets on Physical and Financial parameters along with the nodal cell responsible for achieving the said target are enclosed in Annexure I. A copy of signed MOU incorporating relevant Annexures and the means for verifying the achievement of Non-financial parameter (Annexure B) is also enclosed.
- 3. This time Chairman of the Task Force and DPE has mainly focused on the revival of BSNL and after detailed deliberations with the officers of DOT and BSNL, parameters related to revival of Company has been included under *Initiatives for growth* in MOU 2014-15. TF has also decided to include ongoing projects of Government for various National development programmes under *Completion of New/Ongoing projects during the year*.
- **4.** The most important parameter of the MOU for the year 2014-15 along with their target and weightage in the MoU and Nodal officer in BSNL HQ responsible for the same (i.e GM/Sr GM/PGM) are given below:-
 - **4.1 Static/ Financial Parameters**: (**Wt. 50%):-** It focuses on overall financial performance of BSNL and these parameters has been redefined for the year 2014-15. The Very Good targets for these items for the year 2014-15 is given below:-
 - Sales Turnover = Rs 29,000 Crores
 Gross Operating Margin = Rs 1,180 Crores
 - EBITDA/Net Block = 2.91%
 - Sales turnover / Net Block = 55.23 %

- 4.2 Dynamic/ Non-Financial Parameters: (Wt. 44%):- It predominantly focuses on Initiatives for growth, Project Management & Implementation which consist of CAPEX for Capacity expansion and New/Ongoing projects respectively, Productivity and Internal Process focusing on ARPU of GSM services, Quality of Service & customer satisfaction and Human Resource Management.
- 4.3 Dynamic/Non-Financial Parameters for the FY 2014-15 are :
- 4.3.1 Corporate/ Strategic plan-preparation/ determination/ Identification of Objectives /Goals: (Wt. 10%) It includes following parameters:
 - a) Finalization of Revival Plan of BSNL: CP&M Cell is coordinating this activity with the consultant and will take up this report with BSNL Management for finalization. A target for timeline 30.09.2014 has been fixed ----- Action by GM (CP&M)
 - **b & c)** "Finalization of policy for organizational restructuring and implementation during the year" & "Submission of implementation plan of restructuring of BSNL to DoT": Restructuring Cell will be Coordinating with the consultant for the suggestions on "Organization restructuring" and take up this report with BSNL Management for finalization and for onward submission of "Implementation plan" to DoT. A target for timeline 30.09.2014 and 31.12.2014 has been fixed respectively----Action by GM (Restg.)
 - d) Formulation of policy for HR restructuring: Establishment Cell will be Coordinating with the consultant for the suggestions on HR restructuring and take up this report with BSNL Management for finalization. A target for timeline 31.12.2014 has been fixed ------ Action by GM (Estb.)
 - e) Formulation of subsidiary of BSNL Tower Assets: A target for timeline 31.12.2014 has been fixed ------ Action by GM (Infra Sales)
 - 4.3.2: CAPEX for Capacity expansion: (Wt. 8%) It include following parameters:
 - a) Net addition in O.F. Cable in BSNL network: A target of 20,000 Route Kms has been fixed. ----- Action by Sr. GM (CNP)
 - b) Net addition in GSM Capacity: A target of 100 lakh lines has been fixed.
 -----Action taken by Sr. GM (NWP-GSM)
 - c) Replacement of Legacy Wireline exchanges by NGN: A target of 5 Lakh customer migrations has been fixed. -----Action by Sr. GM (NWP-CFA)
 - 4.3.3 Completion of New/Ongoing projects during the year: (Wt. 14%) It include following parameters:
 - a) Laying of O.F. Cable for Defence Project i.e. Network for Spectrum (NFS):

- c) Commissioning of GSM BTSs to provide mobile coverage in Left Wing Extremist (LWE) areas: A target to commissioning 1,200 GSM BTSs is fixed. ----- Action by GM (NWO-CM).
- 4.3.4 Following two parameters are included under Productivity and Internal Process: (Wt. 7%)
 - a) ARPU for GSM Services of BSNL w.r.t. Industry average (Wt. 1%) -----Action by GM (F) CM / GM (NWO-CM) / GM(NWP-CM)
 - b) Telecom Network Utilization/Downtime- Quality of service & Customer Satisfaction parameters: (Wt. 6 %) It includes all the Quality of Service (QoS) and Customer satisfaction parameters specified for Wire line, Cellular Mobile and Broadband Network. The targets have been fixed as number of Parameters meeting TRAI benchmarks.
 - (i) Wire line Services: A target to meet 13 number of (QoS) and Customer Satisfaction parameters with TRAI benchmarks under Excellent category has been fixed ----- Action by GM (NWO-CFA)/ GM Fin (CFA) / GM (CSC)
 - (ii) Cellular Services: A target to meet 17 number of (QoS) and Customer Satisfaction parameters with TRAI benchmarks under Excellent category has been fixed -------Action by GM (NWO-CM)/ GM Fin (CM) / GM (CSC)
 - (iii) Broadband Services: A target to meet 15 number of (QoS) and Customer Satisfaction parameters with TRAI benchmarks under Excellent category has been fixed ----- Action by GM (NWO-BB & IN) / GM Fin (CFA) / GM (CSC)
 - **4.3.5 Human Resource Management:** (**Wt. 5%**) It includes parameters on training. Task Force, DPE has fixed training under three categories (i) for Fresh recruits (ii) In-House Executives/Employees (iii) Training under national skill development programme- The nodal officer is GM (Training) --------Action by GM (Trg)
 - 4.3.6 Compliance of Corporate Governance has not been included as mandatory parameters in MOU-2014-15, however Non- Compliance of Corporate Governance will be penalized by way of negative marking (Refer Note-B under footnote of Annexure-I of MoU)—Action by CS & GM (Legal).
 - 4.3.7 Non-Compliance of any directives including "Submission of data for Public Enterprises survey" and Non compliance of "MSME Order No. 21(1)/2011-MA dated 25.04.2013" will be penalized by way of negative marking (Refer Note-B under footnote of Annexure-I of MoU) —Action by CS &GM (Legal) and GM (MM) respectively.

- 5.4 Likewise year 2013-14, DPE has insisted for providing supporting documents for verifying the achievement of various non-financial parameters. This is required to be submitted to DPE as a means for verifying the achievement of the non-financial parameter. The means for verifying the achievement based on the inputs received from respective BUs, which has already been communicated to DPE, is enclosed at Annexure B of MOU. It will be relevant to mention that as per the DPE guidelines, non-submission of supporting document for non-financial parameter would entail an automatic downgrading by at least one notch from the rating claimed by the CPSE in respect of the parameters for which the documentary evidence have not been submitted to DPE.
- 5.5 The quarterly progress of various performance parameters starting for the quarter April June 2014 may please be sent to CP&M Cell for documentary evidence by the respective units by 19th of the July and accordingly for all following quarters.
- 6. The progress of BSNL for the financial year 2014-15 will be monitored by DOT on quarterly basis and by DPE by the end of the year. All out efforts be made to achieve the target under 'Excellent' category. You are requested to kindly formulate a strategy/plan in consultation with Director /Executive Director in charge of Business Vertical and coordination with Circle Heads to pave way for targeted outputs.
